Cite source according to its document type, e.g. book, book chapter, or journal article. Add retrieval date and database name.

Cite source as a book or book chapter. (You'll most likely be citing these as chapters.) Add retrieval date and database name.

UpToDate

Use the book chapter format to cite material from UpToDate. The editor is Burton D. Rose, and the publisher is UpToDate in Waltham, MA. They use the current year at the publication date. For more information, go to: Help – User’s Manual – Citing UpToDate topic reviews:

Marion, DW. Diaphragmatic pacing. In: UpToDate, Basow, DS (Ed), UpToDate, Waltham, MA, 2009.

NOTE that the above is not in the APA format. Below is a modified version based on APA style:

Marion, D.W. (2009). Diaphragmatic pacing. In: D.S. Basow (Ed.), *UpToDate*. Waltham, MA: UpToDate.

Books (APA Style)

Author, A. A. (year). *Title of work*. Location: Publisher.

Krause, W.J. (2005). *Krause’s essential human history for medical students*. Boca Raton: Universal Publishers.

Book Chapters (APA Style)

Author, A.A., & Author, B.B. (year). Title of chapter. In A. H. Editor, B. Editor, & C. Editor (Eds.), *Title of book* (pp. xxx-xxx). Location: Publisher.

Jaeschke, R., Guyatt, G., & Lijmer, J. (2002). Diagnostic tests. In G. Guyatt, D. Rennie (Eds.), *Users’ Guides to the Medical Literature* (pp. 121-140). Chicago: AMA.

Journal Articles (APA Style)

Author, A.A., Author, B.B., & Author, C.C. (year). Title of article. *Title of Periodical*, volume, pages-xxx.

Osterberg, L., & Blaschke, T. (2005). Adherence to medication. *The New England Journal of Medicine*, 353, 487-497.
